

## Jack Schrader Camp Director



Jack Schrader, two-time MIAA and South Central Region Coach of the Year, brings his local regional, national and international coaching resume to the Wildcat basketball camps with the idea of making them the best off-season basketball experience in the Tri-state area. Since 1981, Coach Schrader has been in the area as a high school and college coach working with many of the area's top players in his basketball camps and basketball schools. Now at Culver-Stockton, Coach Schrader can for the first time combine his experience with the area's best facilities and

installations along with camp staff in order to provide a great camp experience.

Coach Schrader played high school basketball at Waco of Olds in southeast Iowa. After high school, he walked on at Ellsworth Community College before earning a scholarship to Arizona State University where he played his final three years with the nationally-ranked Sun Devils. He achieved several awards at ASU, including the Sparkplug Award and the Most Improved Player Award. In addition, he was an all-conference and all-academic award winner and team captain during his tenure that saw ASU win two conference championships and finish second once.

Coach Schrader was drafted by the Phoenix Suns and then went on to play and later coach in the Spanish ACB League, which is the NBA's and Team USA's biggest rival for international bragging rights.

At every stop, Coach Schrader's enthusiasm for promoting basketball and developing basketball players has been a top priority. Locally he has coached at LaPlata and Kirksville High Schools before taking over at Truman State University and now at Culver-Stockton College where his dedication to the area and area's best players will continue to thrive.

### REGISTRATION

Enrollment will be limited, so return your application and \$50 deposit by May 31, 2011, for the Earlybird Camp, or July 17, 2011, for the Last Chance Camp, to ensure acceptance. The remainder of the tuition will be due on opening day. Checks should be made payable to Culver-Stockton College.

### CAMP FACILITIES

All camp sessions take place on the campus of Culver-Stockton College. The majority of the camp will take place on the courts of Charles Field House.

Campers will be housed in residence halls located on the Culver-Stockton College campus. Air conditioning is available in all camp housing.

### ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Roommate selections and room assignments will be made at registration. Every attempt will be made at that time to honor requests for roommates as indicated on the application form. Those campers who indicate such preference should attempt to register at the same time as their requested roommate.

### INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE

The Wildcat basketball camps will NOT be responsible for any medical or other medically related charges in connection with a camper's attendance. Each camper's parent or legal guardian will be required to authorize a medical release form that releases the camp, and its directors and employees, from ALL liability for injuries, accidents, and/or illness incurred while at camp. All campers are encouraged to have a physical examination under the care of their family physician prior to attending camp.

### EQUIPMENT NEEDED

A list of needed equipment and other camp information will be sent upon receipt of application.

### REFUNDS

No deposit refunds will be made after June 4, 2011 (EarlyBird Camp) or July 23, 2011 (Last Chance Camp). Any camper leaving camp due to injury will receive a prorated credit good for use at a future camp.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

Campers must follow all rules and regulations of the Wildcat Camp. Any serious violations will result in immediate dismissal from camp without refund.

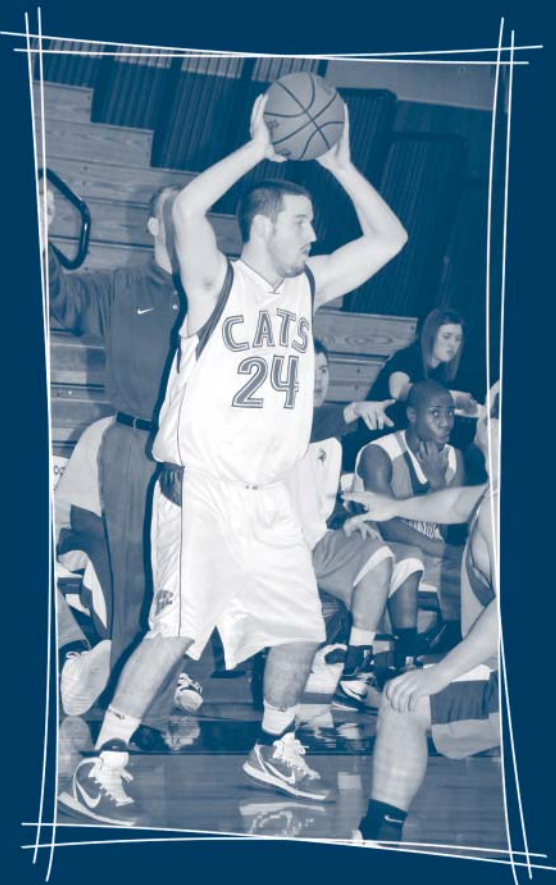
### Staff Members
