Michael Prunty was named Culver-Stockton College's fifth men's soccer coach on January 5, 2011.

Prunty recently completed his only season as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Simpson College in Indianola, Iowa. Prunty, a native of Adel, Iowa, was active in all facets of the program and assisted in recruiting, practice planning and leading weekly strength and conditioning sessions for both the men and women's programs.



Prunty was previously an assistant men's soccer coach at St. Ambrose University in Davenport, Iowa, for two seasons. In 2008, Prunty helped lead the Bees to the NAIA National Tournament and a No. 4 seed in the country. While in Davenport, he co-founded and was the lead coach for Black Select Soccer Club and trained teams with Quad Cities United and the Eastern Iowa Soccer Association. His Black Select teams competed in showcases and tournaments across the Midwest.

Prior to coaching at St. Ambrose, Prunty was a staff trainer and team coach at Colorado United, one of the largest clubs in Denver, Colo. He was team coach for the U11 boys and a staff trainer for the U16 boys, U17 boys, and U17-U18 girls. He also conducted private training sessions for several club members.

Prunty has additional coaching experience coaching in Central Iowa. He was team coach and academy trainer for Vision Soccer Academy. He also assisted with high school programs in Winterset and Waukee, Iowa.

A 2004 graduate of Simpson, Prunty was a starter for the Storm soccer program. He graduated in a bachelor's degree in physical education in 2004, and received his master's of education degree from St. Ambrose University. Prunty also has the NSCAA Premiere Diploma and is an associate staff member for the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA).

CAMP FACILITIES

All camp sessions take place on the campus of Culver-Stockton College. The majority of the camp will take place on the game and practice field at Ayers Soccer Complex, home of the soccer Wildcats, on the western edge of campus.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE

The Wildcat soccer camps will NOT be responsible for any medical or other medically-related charges in connection with a camper's attendance. Each camper's parent or legal guardian will be required to authorize a medical release form that releases the camp, and its directors and employees, from ALL liability for injuries, accidents and/or illness incurred while at camp. All campers are asked to bring a ball, water, shin guards, sun screen and all the enthusiasm and energy needed to have a great week of camp.

No refunds will be made after June 26, 2011. Any camper leaving camp due to injury will receive a pro-rated credit good for use at a future camp.

Individual Instructional Camp

June 27-July 1 (Ages 4-18)

The goal of the Culver-Stockton Soccer Camp is to provide technical, and tactical instruction in a fun environment. Age appropriate instruction will challenge athletes of all levels and direct them towards continued soccer success and enjoyment. This camp is designed for players 4 to 18 years old.

Each day of camp will provide technical instruction that is the foundation of the game of soccer. Players will also be introduced to small and large group tactics that will deepen their understanding of soccer and their role within the team. Small games and activities will pull all the camp topics together and is a staple of the Culver-Stockton Soccer Camp philosophy.

Camp for players 4-6 years of age will run each day from 8-9 a.m., with boys ages 7-18 running from 9-12 p.m. each day. Goalkeeping training will be offered daily.
