



John Windham Camp Director

John Windham begins his second year as director of the Wildcat Basketball Camp.

Before coming to Culver-Stockton, Coach Windham served as head coach at Virginia Episcopal School, a college prep school in Lynchburg, Va., compiling a 96-57 career record. His teams were ranked in the top 10 in the Virginia Independent Conference every season, and he was named conference coach of the year after the 2006-07 season.

Coach Windham also had a successful run at Rowland Hall—St. Mark's School in Salt Lake City, Utah. In five years, his program went from a last place team to a region championship and state semifinal appearance. His team was state-ranked in each of his last three years. He was voted Utah Coach of the Year after the 1999-2000 and the 2001-02 seasons.

In addition, Windham also has experience at the pro level where he was a head coach in Sweden. In his first year at Linkoping, Sweden, Windham coached them to the southern division national championship and compiled a .700 winning percentage

A native of Sterling, Ill., and a graduate of Western Illinois University, Coach Windham brings many years of camp experience. He has worked many basketball camps throughout the United States and Europe

REGISTRATION

Registration application forms should be sent to John Windham, Wildcat Basketball Camp, Culver-Stockton College, Canton, Mo., 63435.

Enrollment will be limited, so return your application and \$50 deposit by June 1 to ensure acceptance. The remainder of the tuition will be due on opening day. Checks should be made payable to Culver-Stockton College.

CAMP FACILITIES

All camp sessions take place on the campus of Culver-Stockton College. The majority of the camp will take place on the courts of Charles Field House and the courts of the basketball facility in the Activity and Recreation Center, located north of Charles Field House.

Campers will be housed in residence halls located on the Culver-Stockton College campus. Air conditioning is available in all camp housing.

ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Roommate selections and room assignments will be made at registration. Every attempt will be made at that time to honor requests for roommates as indicated on the application form. Those campers who indicate such preference should attempt to register at the same time as their requested roommate.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE

The Wildcat basketball camps will **NOT** be responsible for any medical or other medically related charges in connection with a camper's attendance. Each camper's parent or legal guardian will be required to authorize a medical release form that releases the camp, and its directors and employees, from **ALL** liability for injuries, accidents, and/or illness incurred while at camp. All campers are encouraged to have a physical examination under the care of their family physician prior to attending camp.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

A list of needed equipment and other camp information will be sent upon receipt of application.

REFUNDS

No deposit refunds will be made after June 1, 2009, for the first camp, and July 1, 2009, for the second camp. Any camper leaving camp due to injury will receive a prorated credit good for use at a future camp.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Campers must follow all rules and regulations of the Wildcat Camp. Any serious violations will result in immediate dismissal from camp without refund.

Individual Fundamental Camp

June 7-11 and July 12-16

The goal of the Culver-Stockton Wildcat Camp is to teach fundamental skills and team concepts necessary for each participant to become a more complete player.

Each camp day will consist of drills on FUNdamentals, contests, guest speakers, and league play.

Enrollment is limited to ensure individual attention. THIS CAMP HAS FILLED TO CAPACITY IN THE PAST. To reserve your spot, please complete the application form and return it with your \$50 deposit by June 1, 2009, for the first camp; and July 1, 2009 for the second camp.

Registration will be on Sunday, June 7, and Sunday, July 12 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Camp will end between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 11, and Thursday, July 16.

Staff Members

Coach Windham and members of the Culver-Stockton College coaching staff will serve as camp directors in 2009.

Area high school and junior high school coaches will also serve as staff, along with some of the top Wildcat players as counselors and assistant coaches. Ratio of coaches and counselors to campers will be approximately 10:1.
