



Seth Minter Camp Director

Seth Minter is in his first year as director of the Lady Wildcat Basketball Camps.

Minter, a 2006 graduate of Culver-Stockton, spent the last three years as the head girls coach at Canton High School,

which included two trips to the Missouri Class 2 Girls State Basketball Tournament where they finished second in 2009 and fourth in 2010. He compiled a 77-13 overall record at Canton, an .856 winning percentage that is the best in the program's history, and his teams were ranked in the Missouri Coaches Top 10 poll each year, achieving the top ranking in the state during the 2008-09 season.

During his tenure at Canton, Minter oversaw a program that set school records for victories in a season (29) in 2008-09, points per game (67.4), points allowed (38.6), assists per game (17.3) and field goal percentage (54%).

Minter coached six all-state players, eight all-district selections, four 1,000-point scorers, one 2,000-point scorer, and one 1,000-rebounder. He twice was named District Coach of the Year, and was runner-up for the Robert Fairchild Coach of the Year in the State of Missouri in 2009. He was also named KHQA TV 7 and KRES radio Coach of the Year in 2009.

Meleia Niemann Associate Camp Director

Meleia Niemann is back as an assistant coach at Culver-Stockton after a 17-year hiatus. A 1982 C-SC graduate, Niemann was a pioneer in the women's athletic programs at Culver-Stockton.

Niemann was a four-year letterwinner in both basketball and softball for the Lady Wildcats during the infancy of both programs. During her basketball career, Niemann was the first member of the 1,000-point club, finishing with 1,177 career points. As a freshman, Niemann tied the school record for points in a game with 30 against MacMurray College. The next season, she broke the record with a 40-point outburst against Quincy College, a record that still stands today. She is a member of the C-SC Athletic Hall of Fame.

Niemann's other accomplishments while at C-SC include being named an Academic All-American in 1982, a Missouri Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women All-State player in 1981, and team captain in both basketball and softball. After graduating, Niemann assisted the women's basketball program for five seasons (1982-86 and 1992-93), and the Lady Wildcats won the HAAC title four of those five years.

REGISTRATION

Enrollment will be limited, so return your application and \$50 deposit by June 1, 2010, (Varsity Camps) or June 18, 2010, (Fundamental Camp) to ensure acceptance. The remainder of the tuition will be due on opening day. Checks should be made payable to Culver-Stockton College.

CAMP FACILITIES

All camp sessions take place on the campus of Culver-Stockton College. The majority of the camp will take place on the courts of Charles Field House.

Campers will be housed in residence halls located on the Culver-Stockton College campus. Air conditioning is available in all camp housing.

ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Roommate selections and room assignments will be made at registration. Every attempt will be made at that time to honor requests for roommates as indicated on the application form. Those campers who indicate such preference should attempt to register at the same time as their requested roommate.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL CARE

The Wildcat basketball camps will **NOT** be responsible for any medical or other medically related charges in connection with a camper's attendance. Each camper's parent or legal guardian will be required to authorize a medical release form that releases the camp, and its directors and employees, from **ALL** liability for injuries, accidents, and/or illness incurred while at camp. All campers are encouraged to have a physical examination under the care of their family physician prior to attending camp.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

A list of needed equipment and other camp information will be sent upon receipt of application.

REFUNDS

No deposit refunds will be made after June 1, 2010, for the Varsity Only Camps, and June 18, 2010, for the Individual Fundamental Camp. Any camper leaving camp due to injury will receive a prorated credit good for use at a future camp.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Campers must follow all rules and regulations of the Wildcat Camp. Any serious violations will result in immediate dismissal from camp without refund.

Varsity Only Camp June 18-19

The goal of this camp is for basketball players to find another level to their individual game. For two days you can learn to work on your basketball skills and improve your basketball IQ with college coaches and players. In the two days and one night of Varsity camp you will learn the drills that players at the collegiate level do every day. The two-day camp will include four meals, an overnight stay in a residence hall on campus and, culminates with an award ceremony.
